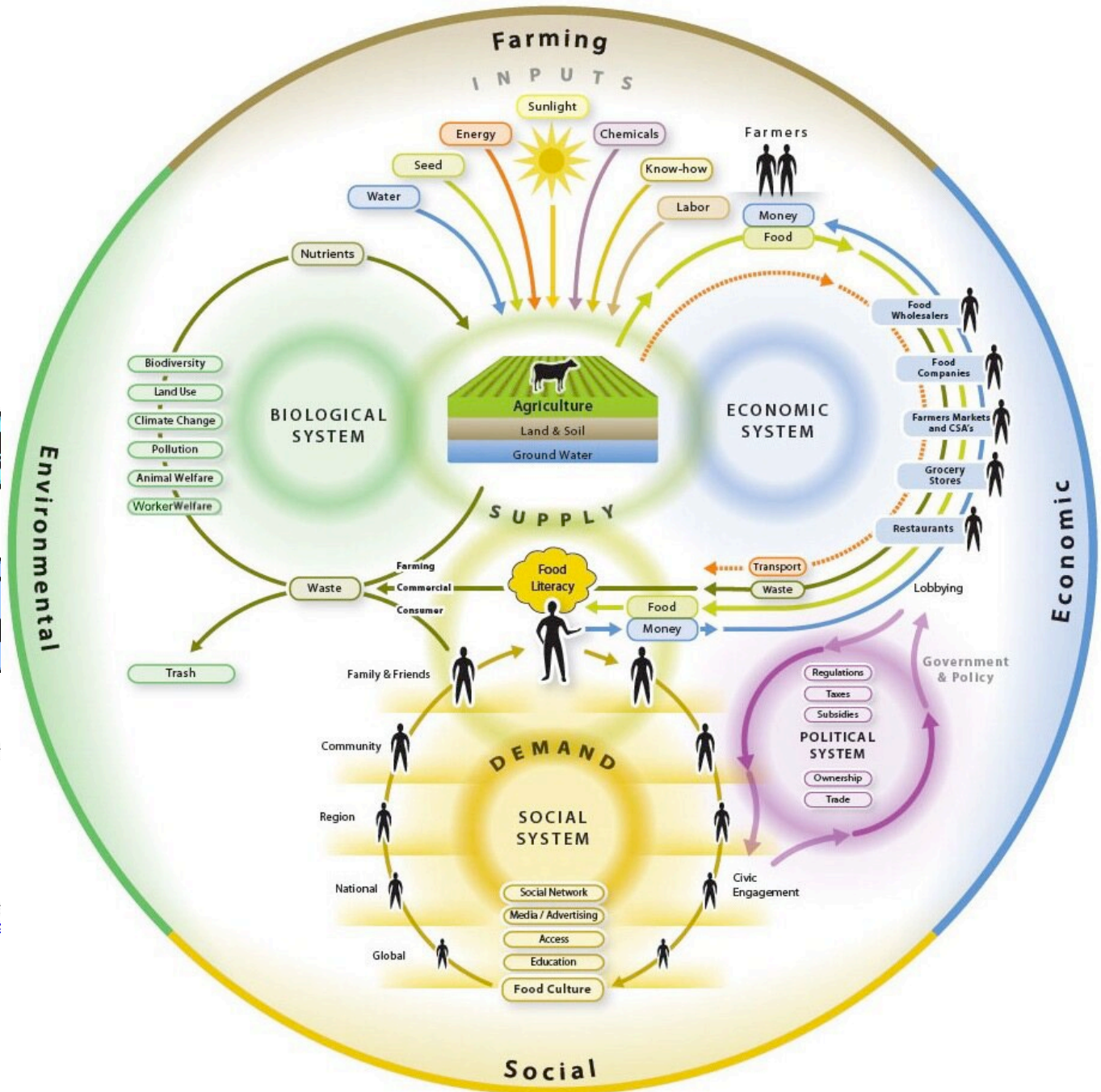
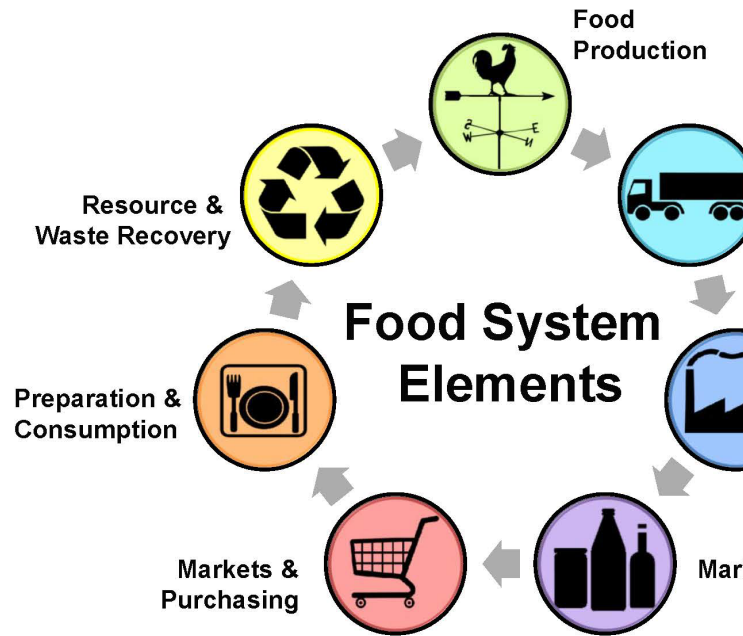

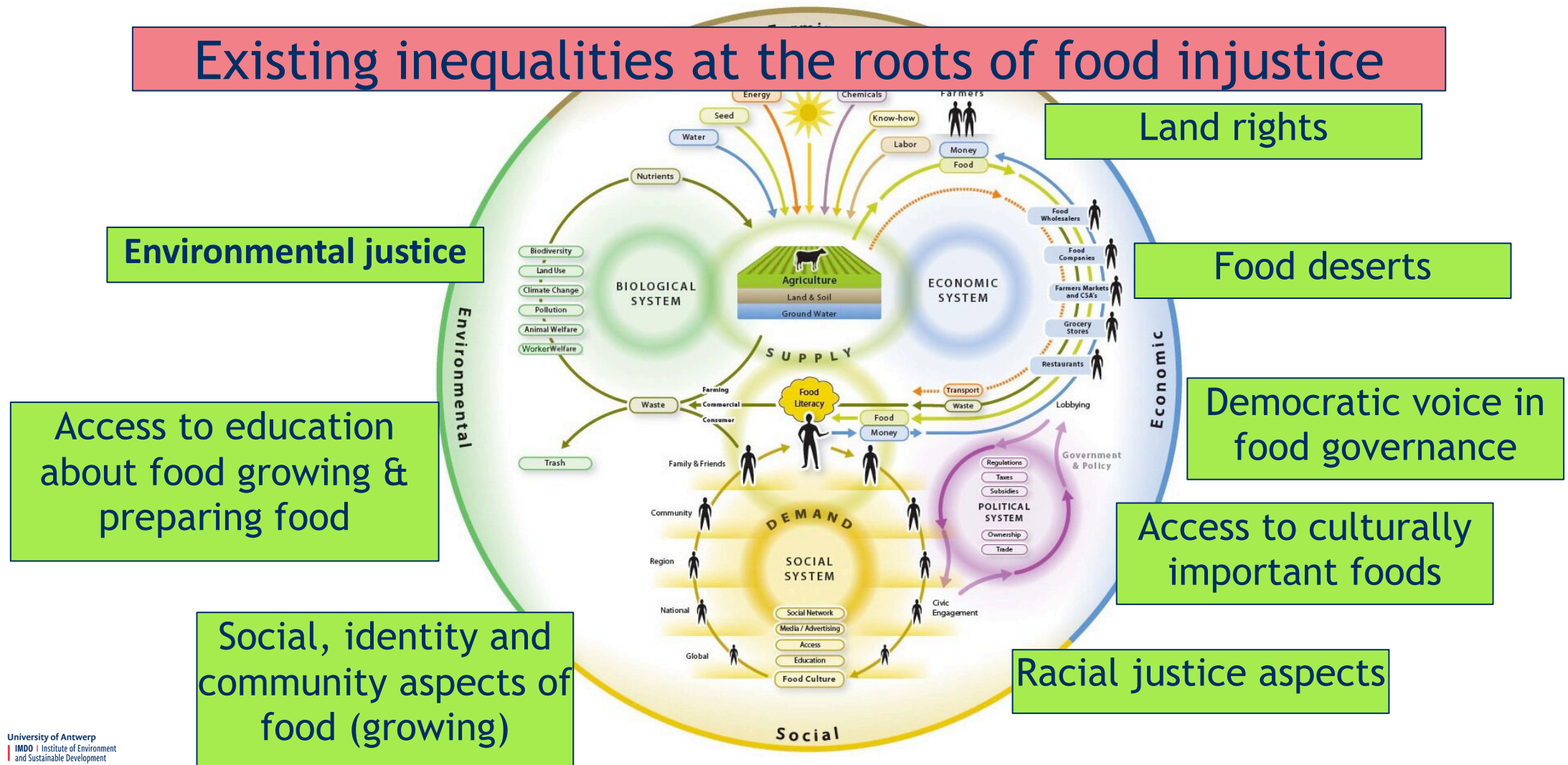

Food injustice in Palestine

- Land taken – access to land, water sources (land rights issue)
- Pushed from independent farms to precarious labour jobs for Israeli export market (labour rights issue)
- No access to traditional and indigenous foods (access to cultural foods justice issue)
- Access to food in Gaza (basic access to food and water)
